How do I talk to my child about race?

Reading is an excellent choice, at any age, to begin conversations about race. Children as young as 3 years old, can demonstrate implicit bias towards other races. Here are some helpful tips about literacy, and exposing your children to diversity around them!

- look at picture books with a variety of races
- ask questions when reading aloud, and allow children to do the same
- acknowledge differences that your child sees
- correct misinformation
- talk in age appropriate ways
- repeat! children learn through repetition. reading and exposing your child to the diverse world around them is no different!
